ATTENTION: SWITCH & SAVE INCENTIVE

MRSPA has extended an invitation to cash members to switch to dues deduction for 2024-2025. If they make the change, they are eligible for a one-time \$10 reduction in state dues. They would pay \$40 for state dues for 2024-2025, plus their local dues amount. Members need to complete and return the 2024-2025 Dues Deduction Authorization Form, which is available on the MRSPA website under "Switch and Save" (https://www.mrspa.org/switch-and-save). Current Cash dues payers, who have not yet paid their dues, would be eligible for "Switch and Save".
